> IVES Technical Reviews is a tool to transfer current vine and wine research to end users, i.e. consultants, enologists, agronomists, experts, teachers, students, winegrowers, equipment suppliers, and people working in biotechnological and chemical industries. The articles published are sourced from OENO One and other scientific or technical journals. They are available in English, French, German, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese. Topics investigated range from viticulture and enology to economics, sociology and health.
